

How to install the Mobile Authenticator software on a phone

The Microsoft Authenticator app is available for [Android](#), [iOS](#), and [Windows Phone](#). To get the best experience, let the app get notifications when asked.

1. If possible, go to the [Additional security verification](#) screen on another PC or device. For information about how to get to this screen, see [Changing the security settings](#) or contact a system administrator.
2. Check the box next to **Authenticator app**, and then select **Configure**.






3. The **Configure mobile app** screen appears with a QR code for you to scan with the authenticator app.



4. Open the Microsoft Authenticator app. On the **Accounts** screen, select **Add account**, and then select **Work account**.
Note: If the camera isn't working properly, then [enter the QR code and URL manually](#).
5. Use the device's camera to scan the QR code, and then select **Done** to close the QR code screen.

The **Accounts** screen of the app shows the account name and a six-digit verification code. For additional security, the verification code changes every 30 seconds preventing someone from using the same code twice.
